

Teaching and Learning Content : Photography Year Group: 12

Autumn Term

Portfolio: Skills based project/ Opposite Project

Key Questions: (A list of key questions)

- What makes a good photograph?
- What makes a good portrait photograph?
- How do you create depth of field?
- How do you create motion blur?
- How could you explore the idea 'Opposites?'
- What photographers use these techniques?
- What do you like about the photographers work?

Students will: (A short description of outcomes)

- Students will explore their ideas by researching different techniques and photographers. Gathering information and images, which will help them, develop their work.
- They will be able to explain and show techniques and their own opinions about different photographers.

Spring Term

Opposite Project/ AS Exam

Key Questions:

- What makes a good final piece?
- What techniques could you use when producing a final piece?
- What other photographer's link to your idea?
- What do you like about their work and how does it link to your idea?
- What photographers look at your exam question?

Students will:

- Need to explore their ideas and come up with a final Opposite piece.
- Students will continue to research techniques and photographers linked to their ideas, gathering examples and information to help them to produce their idea.
- Students will begin to research their ideas and photographers for their final exam.

Summer term

Final Exam

Key Questions:

- What do you like about their work and how does it link to your idea?
- What techniques could you use to produce your final exam piece?

Students will:

- Explore and research your exam question.
- They will look at four possible ideas and choose the one.
- They will explain why they have chosen this idea and how it links to the exam question and photographer.
