Year 11 exam focus focuses on professionalism and the principles of care and covers key topic areas such as:

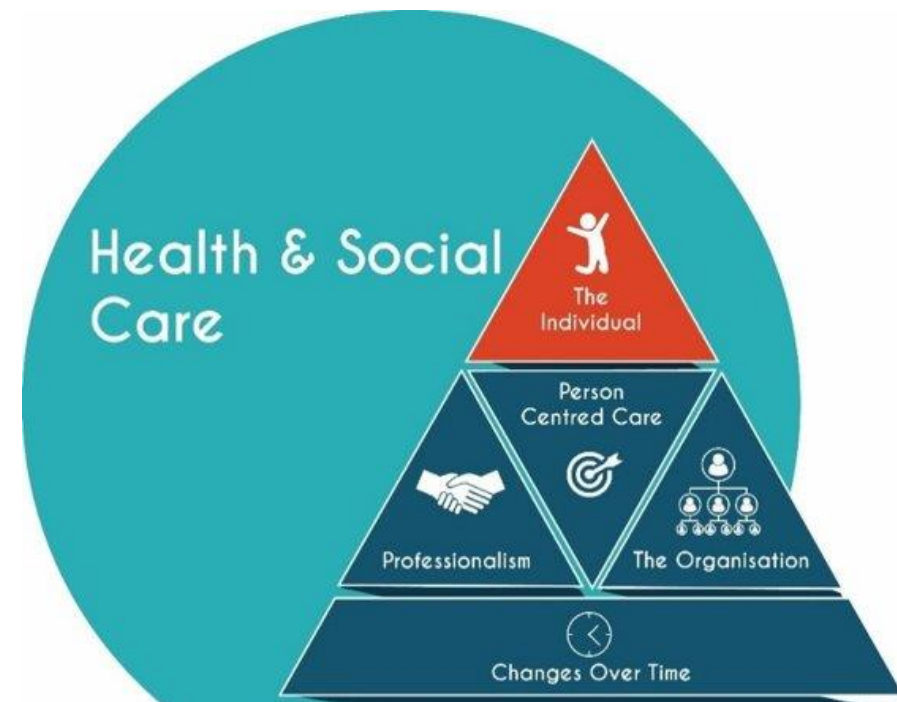

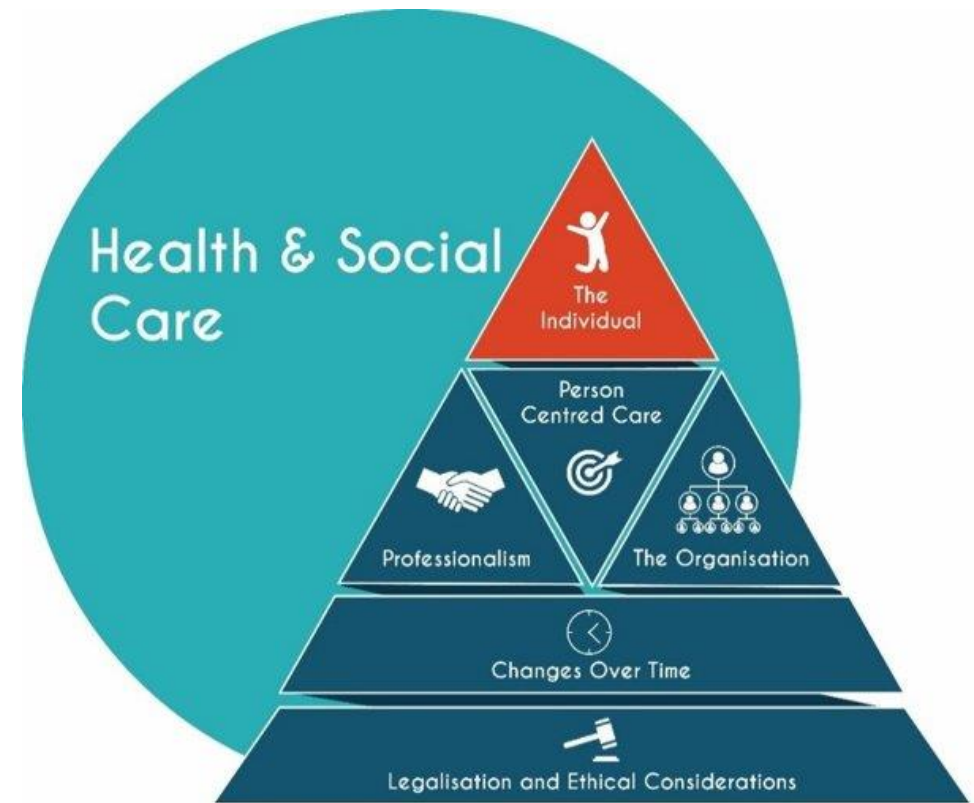

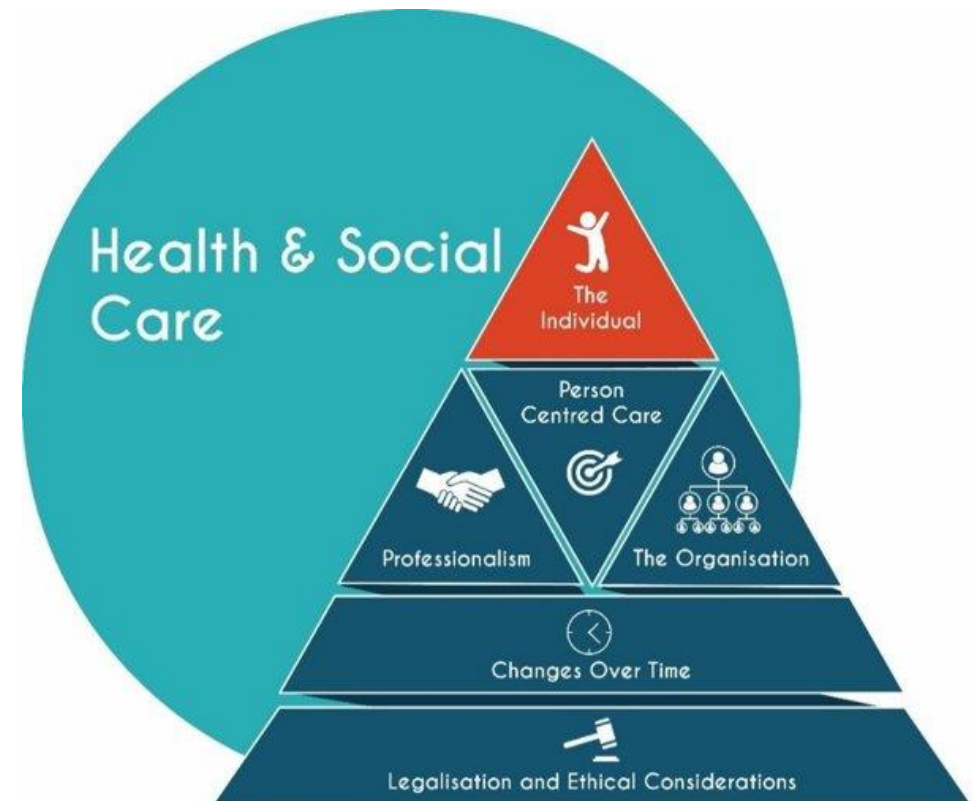
