

Post 16 Select Dress Code

The objectives of the dress code are to:

- Promote a positive image of Post 16 students as role models
- Promote the self-esteem of Post 16 students
- Prepare students for the world of work

Permitted:

- Shirt **and** tie
- Blouse or smart top (not branded)
- Smart trousers, skirt, dress or cropped trousers (no jeggings, leggings, chinos, jeans or Bodycon skirts) Skirts and dresses must be knee length
- Smart jacket (blazer), cardigan or jumper – v neck or round neck (shirt or blouse collar must be visible at the top)
- Thin spaghetti strap tops are permitted if worn with a blazer or suit jacket
- Traditional / cultural wear
- Smart shoes or boots, which can be polished (no knee/thigh high boots)
- Stud or small earrings only
- Stud facial piercings only
- Student lanyard must be worn at all times



Not permitted:

- Tops which are low cut, cropped, cut out, off the shoulder, t-shirt, turtleneck, casual flannel / lumberjack checked shirt
- Hoodies or sweatshirts
- Short skirts / tube or body con style dresses / skirts of stretchy material (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)
- Trainers, pumps, open toed shoes, UGG style boots, espadrilles
- Shorts, leggings or chino style trousers
- Sports jackets
- Denim or leather clothing
- Ear stretchers/Bandanas
- Coat or jacket worn in the school building
- Shirt without a tie

The Post 16 College Leadership reserves the right to determine the suitability of clothes. Sanctions will be put in place for students who do not adhere to the correct dress code.
