Re: Coronavirus COVID-19 Update

Over the last few days I have spoken to all of our students in assemblies about the potential impact of a worsening of the current situation. As you are aware, we are receiving and following daily advice from public health agencies. You will be aware that there may come a time when the Government decides there is a need to move to stage 2 of their action plan; they have said that this may involve school closure. At present, we have not been asked to close. If we are, then of course we will comply with these requests. Should there be a period of closure we will ensure that all students are provided with appropriate work for the period in question. This is especially important for those students (Year 11 and Year 13) who are currently studying for public examinations. If we are closed at any point, we will do our very best to continue to support all students to the very best of our ability.

In the meantime, I would ask you all to continue following all of the relevant advice on offer from public health agencies.
