<p><b>Topic: Portrait</b>  <b>What do you want students to know?</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Understand what the difference is between Street Art &amp; Graffiti Art</li> <li>Learn about the graffiti portrait Artist MTO</li> </ol> <p><b>What do you want them to produce to demonstrate learning?</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information sheet about MTO &amp; Graffiti/Street Art Task 1 is to read slide 3 and answer the questions on slide 4 (remember to use full sentences to answer your questions)</li> <li>Produce a drawing of MTO's artwork by selecting one of the images from slide 5 .</li> </ol> <p><b>Week 3 Learning Objective:</b>  <b>Activity 1:</b></p> <div data-bbox="100 726 515 1005"> <p><b>Who is MTO?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Moto aka MTO is a French artist known for his grey scaled photorealistic works of art, mostly portraits, which stand out from the masses because of their high quality, that led him to become a respected artist in the graffiti and street art scene.</li> <li>he was born in France, and then moved to Berlin in 2006, just to have a 77 street label and that pretty much sums up that he is willing to retire about himself. Visiting Barcelona was his inspiration for MTO's work on the streets. The vibrancy of the city's exterior culture inspired him to create his work, although heaved street art goes way beyond graffiti.</li> <li>MTO sprays his portraits with a typical red outline (that's part of the artwork and his signature and the same thing) – usually of people who inspired him. For that reason he started painting murals like the young MTO'see above, Ray Charles or Jimmy Neutron but also movie actors and their most interesting film scenes, like the kidnapping from "Shining", Robert De Niro from "Taxi Driver" or Angelina Jolie from "Tomb Raider".</li> <li>The portraits are 8-9 feet high and wide and it takes him about 2-3 hours to finish one piece which usually smearing when you take the quality of his work in consideration. His art also interacts with the environment around it.</li> </ul> <p><b>Difference between Graffiti Art &amp; Street Art</b></p> <p>Graffiti Art is word-based, whereas Street Art is image-based.</p> <p><b>Main Features of Graffiti Art</b></p> <p>Graffiti is word based and used to advertise or express parts of urban culture. It draws attention to issues that are raised by the artist or writer applying the graffiti message.</p> <p>Graffiti has a culture and language of its own with expressions like a 'burner' referring to a tag with two colors, black and chrome. A 'throw up' refers to the use of more than one color and a 'blockbuster' is an expression used to describe a piece of graffiti that went up on the wall very quickly.</p> <p><b>Main Features of Street Art</b></p> <p>The street artist uses equipment like projectors, ladders and scissor lifts, to achieve the best effects to the work while considering advice their ability.
