Roll a dice (you might be able to download a dice app on your phone if you don't have a real one) to get a grid reference. For each image you roll, explain how the emoji links to the Elizabethan England topic.</p> <p>E.g. 1, 1, the picture of the ship relates to the design of English ships which were smaller, faster and more manoeuvrable than the Spanish, helping them to defeat the Spanish Armada.</p> <p>Elizabethan England Timeline.</p> <p>Create an overview timeline of all the key events in the Elizabethan England topic.
