Dear Parents/Carers

The Department for Education have launched a scheme to offer free temporary increases to mobile data allowances. All information is available on the .gov.uk website [here](#).

This scheme is open to children and young people who:

- don't have access to a [fixed broadband connection](#)
- cannot afford the additional data needed to access educational resources or social care services
- have access to a mobile device that uses a participating network (currently EE, Sky Mobile, Smarty, Tesco Mobile, Three and Virgin Mobile).
- are facing disruption to their face-to-face education, or have been advised not to attend school

The school has to apply for this extra data allowance on your behalf, so should you wish to apply please [fill in this form](#) as soon as possible.

The form will take you no more than two minutes to complete, and will ask you for the account holder's name, the mobile number (a number beginning with '07'), the mobile network, and whether you pay monthly or pay as you go. You will also need to confirm that you have read the [DfE Privacy Statement](#).
