

## **POST 16 SELECT DRESS CODE**

## The objectives of the dress code are to:

- · Promote a positive image of Post 16 students as role models
- Promote the self-esteem of Post 16 students
- · Prepare students for the world of work

## **Permitted:**

- Shirt and tie
- Blouse
- · Smart trousers, skirt, dress or cropped trousers
- Smart jacket (blazer), cardigan or jumper v neck or round neck (shirt or blouse collar must be visible at the top)
- Thin spaghetti strap tops permitted if worn with a blazer or suit jacket
- Traditional / cultural wear (please note, smart shoes must be worn with this)
- Smart shoes or boots
- Stud or small earrings/Stud facial piercings only
- Student badge must be worn at all times

## Not permitted:

- Tops which are low cut, cropped, cut out, off the shoulder, t-shirt, turtleneck, casual flannel / lumberjack style checked shirt
- Hoodies or sweatshirts
- Short skirts / tube or body con style dresses / skirts of stretchy material (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)
- Trainers, pumps, open-toed shoes, UGG style boots, espadrilles
- Shorts, leggings or chino style trousers
- · Sports jackets
- · Denim or leather clothing
- Ear stretchers/bandanas
- · Coat or jacket worn in the school building
- · Shirt without a tie

Sanctions will be put in place for students who do not adhere to the correct dress code.
